»»» PROM program - new recruitment, new opportunities

The National Agency for Academic Exchange announced a competition under the PROM SHORT-TERM ACADEMIC EXCHANGE Program. According to the recruitment announcement, eligible project participants are students studying at first- and second-cycle studies, long-cycle master's studies, doctoral studies or at a doctoral school; (min. 70%), and people working in higher education and science institutions (constituting no more than 30% of the participants of the entire project).

The program is a continuation of two previous calls for proposals implemented from POWER funds. A novelty is the possibility of offering scholarships also for students of first- and second-cycle studies and uniform master's studies.

PROM provides for financing short-term mobilities aimed at improving the competences of students, doctoral students and academic staff, i.e.: participation in a conference abroad, obtaining materials for a doctoral thesis, a scientific article, participation in a summer/winter school, participation in preparation of an international grant application, etc.
