Application Procedure: The Concept Phase



Step 1: Preliminary Analysis

- Consult your idea with the Project Incubator (Contact: Paulina Pawelska).
- Verify your competition chances and fit for the specific grant.



Step 2: Proposal Preparation

- Developing the project concept.
- Substantive work on the content of the application.

Application Procedure: Registration & Finalization

Step 3: Registration (eProjekty)



- Submit the form via the Employee Portal.
- Collection of formal approvals: Dean, Financial Service Department/Bursar, Vice-Rector.



CRITICAL: Submission must be at least 5 days before the final call deadline.

Step 4: Finalization



The Office provides technical and formal support for the final submission of the proposal.
