»»» EUREKA: Global Innovation Summit 2026 – 6 May in Basel

On 6 May 2026, Basel will host the [Global Innovation Summit 2026](#), one of the key events in the international innovation calendar, organised under the [EUREKA](#) initiative, the world's largest network supporting research and development cooperation. This year's edition is organised by Switzerland, which is concluding its presidency of EUREKA.

The Summit will be held in parallel with [Swiss Biotech Day](#), creating a unique space for dialogue between global business, the scientific community and Switzerland's dynamic biotechnology ecosystem. The programme will include matchmaking sessions, enabling the establishment of international partnerships and discussions on joint research and development projects.

Innovators, researchers, entrepreneurs, policymakers and funding institutions are invited to take part. Polish participants are encouraged to register via the [event website](#), where the agenda is also available.

»»» NCBR: AGROSTRATEG – First Call Opens on 14 May

The National Centre for Research and Development (NCBR) is launching the [first call under the strategic programme AGROSTRATEG](#), aimed at implementing innovative solutions to increase the efficiency of the Polish agricultural sector while taking into account the principles of sustainable development.

The programme covers four research areas: sustainable plant and animal production, digital agriculture, and innovative agricultural techniques. Funding is available for projects implemented by enterprises and consortia involving research organisations, including industrial research and experimental development activities.

The call for proposals will be open from 14 May to 28 August 2026. The maximum funding per project is PLN 25 million, with a total budget of PLN 300 million. Detailed information and call documentation are available on the [NCBR](#) website.
